Please be reminded for safeguarding reasons no one is to enter the school building unless brought in by member of staff. If you need to enter the building please come to the school office.

Please check that you have ordered your child's hot meals. Please log in and order right up to the Christmas holidays. The cut-off date for ordering for after half term is midnight on Monday 25th October



Please remember if your child shows any signs of COVID (a high temperature – above 37.8 degrees, a new continuous cough, or a loss of taste or smell) they are kept home and a PCR test is taken (please mention this when leaving a message on the absence line). Please remember that LFD tests are not for people with symptoms. We also need you to call the absent line by 9am every day your child is off school even if we know the reason.

The 'Reading is Fun' challenge starts as soon as the children leave school on Friday 22nd October. They will then have the whole fortnight to read and raise sponsorship money. Your child will be sponsored for each book that is read to them, read by them or read with someone else.

Sponsor forms should then be returned to school by Friday 5th November with the sponsor money.
