TOP SECRET MISSION

As you are aware, the Key Stage 1 National Curriculum Tests will be taking place, in school, over a period of two weeks, starting from Monday 15th May 2023. Your child's class teacher will use the results from these tests, along with the work that your child has completed throughout the year, to help them reach their own judgements about how your child has progressed.

We want to ensure that the administration of the tests is as stress-free and enjoyable as possible for the children. In order to achieve this, we will be introducing the tests as 'Secret Agent Tasks' (known to the adults as the SATs). During the week before the tests are taking place, the children will be invited to a 'TOP SECRET' assembly in the hall, where they will receive a letter, from the King, asking them to become agents for the week, completing 'TOP SECRET' tasks. During the fortnight, the children will be asked to complete a number of tasks: two reading tests and two maths tests. We will be asking all of the children to try their very best and to work by themselves. Each day, the children will gain class points for the tests completed. At the end of their mission, all of the children will be rewarded with a certificate and a surprise event.

Please do not share this information with your child, as we would like it to be a surprise when they receive their secret mission letter! The attached leaflet provides you with some additional information regarding the SATs.
