

Brilliant Book Week: 4th March - 8th March 2024



Every year we run a Book Week in school. It is a really special week where the children are given extra opportunities to pick up a book and read. We want all of our children to be excellent readers and to have a love of reading and books. Therefore, we have planned a range of activities to take place across the week and beyond. Here are some of the activities that will be happening this year:

Travelling book fair — Wednesday 20th March, Thursday 21st March, Friday 22nd March and Monday 25th March.

On the dates above, we will have a book fair in school to give the children the opportunity to buy a new book. Every child will be issued with a World Book Day voucher for £1, which they can spend at the fair (with a minimum spend of £2.99), Please read the terms and conditions on the back of the voucher. The £1 book voucher can also be used to purchase a £1 Book Week book from selected shops. Book vouchers will be sent home during the week before the book fair arrives. The book fair will be open from 3:15pm until 3:45pm and will be held in the school hall each day.
