Financial support is available from our local music hub, SoundStorm, for lessons, ensemble fees, events, exams.....

## Who can apply?

Any young person who is...

- Aged 5 18 years old
- In full-time education or resident across Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole (Free school, Local Authority maintained or an Academy)
- Looking to participate in/progress in music but is unable to cover the full fees
- Aged 16 18 but currently not in employment, training or education\*
  - \*Applications must be supported in writing with a letter from Youth or social worker/Responsible adult (Music Director)

## What can I apply for?

You can apply for financial assistance of up to £300. The grant can be used to part-fund individual tuition fees, membership of an ensemble, taking part in a summer school (musical), taking an exam or attending a particular event that supports progression. We will also consider applications requesting support for National ensemble applications.
