Please note - we only contact successful applicants for clubs - we do not contact everyone who does not get a place.

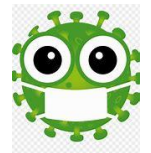
Due to limited space we can only allow parents/carers with a school parking permit to park in the Carpark. If you think you qualify for a permit please contact the school office.

Please remember if your child shows any signs of COVID (a high temperature - above 37.8 degrees, a

new continuous cough, or a loss of taste or smell) they are kept home and a PCR test is taken (please mention this when leaving a message on the absence line). Please remember that LFD tests are not



for people with symptoms. We also need you to call the absent line by 9am every day your child is off school even if we know the reason.
