Whole School Curriculum Workshops

As part of our home and school partnership, which we greatly value, we are very pleased to invite you to join us for our curriculum workshop evening on Thursday 2nd October from 3:30-5:30pm. During this evening, there will be 2 workshops: EYFS phonics/maths and KS1 maths (times shown below). You are very welcome to attend both workshops or you may decide that only one is relevant to your child/children this year. The workshops will take place in the school hall, so please arrive at the school's main entrance and enter by the office. During both workshops, we are pleased to offer a creche for school aged children, and this will be supervised by some of our teachers.

EYFS phonics/maths workshop at 3:30-4:30pm

The phonics aspect of this workshop will include the following: how we teach phonics; the letter sound pronunciations and successful strategies and games that you can use at home to support your child with their reading and writing. A good understanding of phonics will provide the children with firm foundations for all future learning.

During this workshop, we will also include the following: ways to develop and improve a number of your child's maths skills, including subitising and understanding and using numbers; the Early Learning Goals and maths curriculum; what the children are being taught and how (concrete, pictorial and abstract) and how you can support your child at home with maths.

Year 1 and Year 2 maths workshop at 4:45-5:30pm

During this workshop, we will share ways to develop and improve your child's maths skills. These skills will include counting, understanding and using numbers, calculating and solving simple
