Year 2 – The Cockle Trail Walk

Year 2 are now halfway through their exciting 'Globetrotters' topic. We are learning about the country of Kenya, focusing on an area in the suburbs of Nairobi and comparing this to the area that we live in – Poole. To further the children's knowledge and understanding of Poole's heritage, we would like to take them to Poole Quay to complete 'The Cockle Trail Walk'. We will show the children historically significant landmarks and help them to understand some of the historical events in our own locality, including the history behind Poole Harbour (pirates and trade). We will also pop into the Poole Museum to have a look at their primary and secondary sources.

The children will be travelling by minibus to and from Poole Quay, leaving school at 9.00am and returning to school in time to have their lunch.
