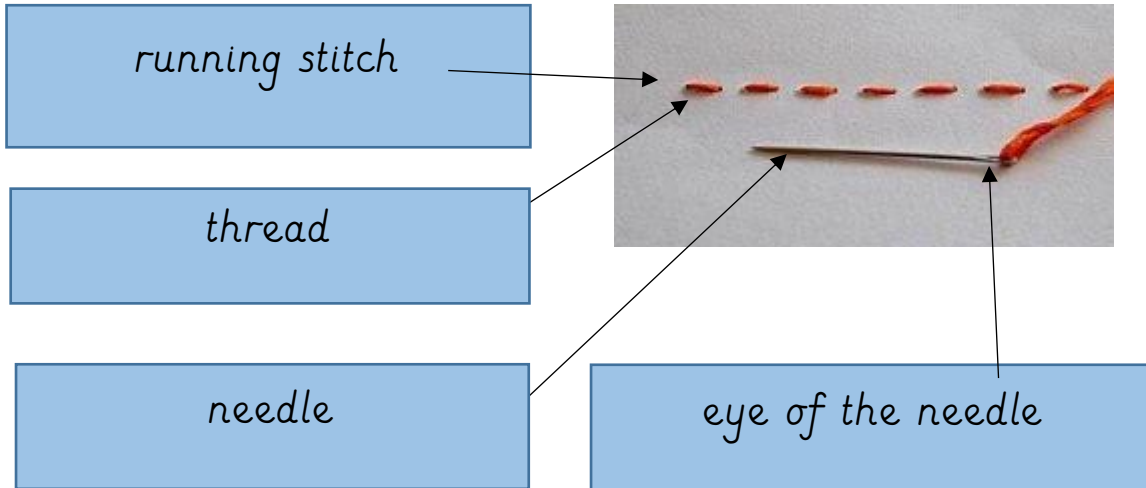


Big Bad Wolf - Design and Technology

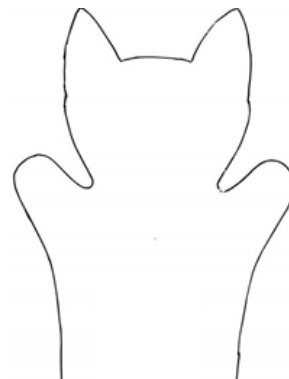


Key Vocabulary	
sewing	Making, joining or mending material with a needle and thread
stitch	A link made by drawing a thread through material by means of a needle (to join material together)
thread	A long, thin strand of material used for sewing
needle	A sharp, thin piece of metal that makes a hole in material
template	A shape that can be drawn and then cut around
eye of a needle	Where the thread goes through the needle (to attach)
felt	A type of fabric



Looking at puppet examples will help us to create design criteria.

Following the design criteria will help us plan, make and evaluate a successful puppet.



You can use a template to cut around so that your fabric is the right size and shape.

Using the running stitch, you can attach pieces of fabric together.

- have good hygiene (keeping clean, healthy teeth, clean clothes)

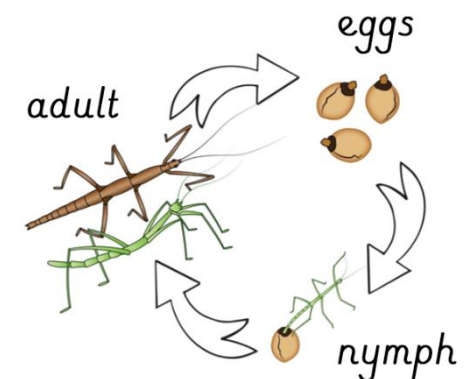
Key Vocabulary

offspring	A person or animals baby
chrysalis	A hard shell that protects a caterpillar when it changes into a butterfly or moth
spawn	The eggs from a frog
hatches	When a baby animal comes out of its egg or shell
larva	The stage between an egg and when animals change into an adult e.g egg, larva, adult
nymph	A young form of an insect
cocoon	A silky case spun by the larvae of insects

- Animals have offspring that grow into adults.



- Offspring change as they grow from a baby to an adult.
- This is called a lifecycle.

Abraham	A significant person in many religions. Jewish people believe that God promised to look after Abraham's family and religion.
10 Commandments	The 10 important rules in the Bible and Torah that God gave to Moses.
respect	Showing care for the feelings and rights of others, and listening to what they have to say.
Synagogue	The special place for Jews.
religion	Belief in a God or Gods.
beliefs	Having trust or faith in something, like God.
Torah	The special book for Jewish people.
Judaism	The religion of people who believe in one God and follow teachings from the Torah.
Jew/Jewish	People who follow the religion of Judaism.
culture	The beliefs and customs of a group of people.
Moses	A prophet who help Jews form a special relationship with God

Focus: What is important to Jews?



The Torah is the most sacred, holy book in Judaism. It is significant for Jews because

- it teaches Jews about stories, laws and how to live close to God;
- it is read in the synagogues;
- it is treated with great respect.

A synagogue is a Jewish place of worship and a community centre where Jewish people pray, study, and socialise.
