YEAR 2 - Moors Valley Country Park Trip

For the children's final school trip at Ad Astra Infant School, we will be going on a special visit to Moors Valley Country Park in Ashley Heath. This is always a very memorable trip for Year 2 and a really exciting way to end the year before the children go onto their new schools.

The trip is on Monday 26th June 2023 and will last for the whole school day.

They will also need a waterproof coat in case the weather is cold or wet. If it is a hot day, please supply your child with an additional water bottle, a hat and ensure that you have already applied appropriate sun cream to your child before they come to school. Please also ensure that your child has an appropriate and comfortable rucksack in which to store their water and packed lunch. If your child has a school lunch booked, they will be given a packed lunch to place in their own rucksack before departing on the trip.
