## Transition Information for children in Early Years — Year 5

I am writing to inform you that our annual 'Transition' day takes place on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June. On this day, children will meet their new teacher for 2023/2024 and find out which class they are going to be in.

The children currently in Early Years and Year 1 will meet their new teacher between morning break and lunch and will come to school and leave at the end of the school day as normal.


Our children in Years 2 and 6 will spend the day at their new schools. We wish our Year 6s the very best of luck for their first day at their secondary schools. If your child will be attending a Dorset school rather than a BCP school, they will be expected to attend school as normal on Friday 30th June, as Dorset transition days take place on a different date.

The Junior School looks forward to welcoming all the Infant School Year 2s. The Year 2 children are to be brought to the junior school's main playground gate where they will be greeted by junior school staff who will show them into the hall. Parents/carers will need to collect the current Year 2 children from the junior school quiet play area at the end of the day (3:10pm). Parents can access the quiet play area through the gate at the end of the Year 4 areas, near to the bike sheds. There will plenty of staff around to signpost you where to go at the start and the end of the day.

Children in our current Year 3, 4 and 5 classes will come into school and go to their current classes as normal however the end of day arrangements for our current Year 3 and 4 will be as follows:

Current Year 3 children will exit school through the gate that leads into quiet play. Parents are asked to wait in the SLT carpark or near the bike sheds.

Current Year 4 children will exit onto the main playground and should be collected from there. Current Year 5 children will exit onto the main playground and should be collected from there.
