Biscuits


Breakfast cereals

Tinned meat and fish


So that we ensure that we donate essential items which will help other, please can you ensure that all goods have a use by date of at least 3 months in the future.
































We hope you will agree that this is a very worthwhile cause. Poole Food Bank have informed us that the donations are very much appreciated by the families who benefit from them.
